SHOW RULES

1. The show is governed by the Official ARBA Show Rules and filling an entry indicates acceptance of those rules and the ones listed below.
2. The show is governed by the latest ARBA Rules.
3. R&CBAC may refuse to accept any entry as they see fit.
4. No smoking is allowed in the showroom.
5. The RCBAC and the Washington County Fairgrounds/AG Society are not responsible for loss in the event of fire, theft, or vandalism, nor is it responsible for exposure to COVID-19 or RHDV2. Attendees participate at their own risk.
6. Exhibitors, visitors, and vendors are responsible for any damage done, or damage to the property. This includes anyone that comes with you.
7. Rabbits that are disqualified in one show due to contagious illness, such as those displaying white nasal discharge or vent disease, will be automatically scratched from subsequent shows and must be removed from the showroom. No refunds will be provided.
8. No entry changes or corrections will be made at the show. No exceptions.
9. Any changes made at the table will be null and void. If the entry is not the same as what was originally entered, it does not exist. There will be no refunds and no awards received. Any award received must be returned.
10. Once entry fees are paid, no refunds shall be given if exhibitor chooses to remove their animal from competition, or if they are asked to be removed from the showroom according to any of the above-mentioned conditions.
11. Parents and guardians must be responsible for their children and any damage they may cause.
12. RCBAC reserves the right to substitute or secure additional judges and/or registrars. The RCBAC also reserves the right to cancel the show due to safety concerns.
13. Rabbits must be permanently tattooed in the left ear, cavies tagged in the left ear. Illegible or missing tattoos or tags will be disqualified.
14. All exhibitors are responsible for listening and getting their animals to the table when the breed is called.
15. Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their area neat and tidy, and walkways free of obstruction. **Exhibitors are also responsible for cleaning up their space at the end of the show.**
16. No animals other than rabbits/cavies allowed in the showroom except seeing-eye or service companions.
17. Ribbons and awards must be picked up at the entry table.
18. Returned check will be charged \$25. Winnings, points, and future privileges to show will depend on restitution.
19. Any rabbit entered in fur must be entered in the regular class.
20. Any decision made by the show superintendent is final.
21. After entries are submitted, no refunds given as judges are hired based on pre entries.
22. Absolutely NO request for judges will be accepted.
23. Must be an entered exhibitor in order to sell rabbits.
